WHAT IS SLSA?

During 2004 — 2005 a group of volunteers committed to improving the quality and quantity of Skeleton Lake water established the Skeleton Lake Stewardship Association.

The Skeleton Lake Stewardship Association is a non-profit society consisting of a volunteer 10 member Board of Directors, a volunteer administrator and more than 900 concerned and interested members.

Members of the SLSA consist primarily of Skeleton lake cottagers, home owners, long term RV'ers, patron campers , community and county residents. However, our goal is to improve the quality and quantity of Skeleton Lake's ecosystem for the benefit of all lake users including the thousands of people who use the lake each year and do not have property or RV sites on the lake.

THE PROBLEM

- * Skeleton lake is at its lowest level in 40 years.
- * The aquatic eco-system of Skeleton lake has been upset.
- * Quality of the water is in serious decline endangering the sustainability of the lake.
- * Riparian areas have been damaged.
- * Fish spawning habitats are decreasing.
- * Almost 50 million gallons of water are pumped out of Skeleton Lake each year for domestic and commercial purposes.

THE SOLUTION

Members of SLSA are committed to increasing water flow into Skeleton Lake, decreasing water outflow from Skeleton Lake and protecting and managing Skeleton Lake's aquatic eco-system.

We are proposing a man-made diversion of water into Skeleton Lake from an appropriate water source in the area. Engineering studies and biological assessments will be conducted. The Village of Boyle will be assisted to find an alternate source of water.
